

## Common Transfer Equivalencies

### Liberal Studies Colloquia

LS 179 or 379		Nothing automatically transfers
LS 479 (or HUM 414)		Nothing automatically transfers

### ILS Humanities Core Cluster

HUM 124	Min 3 sh	Western or World Civilization I; Ancient Civilization; Early Greece and Rome
HUM 214	Min 3 sh	Western or World Civilization II; Renaissance and Reformation; Medieval History; Middle Ages
HUM 324		Nothing automatically transfers

### ILS Arts Course

ILS Arts	Min 3 sh	Nothing automatically transfers. If 3 hours of applied arts courses or workshops were completed, student can petition the Arts program director for credit.
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### Learning Foundations

Foundations of Academic Writing (LANG 120)	Min 3 sh	Student must complete at least the second semester of composition at a previous institution.
Foreign Language	0-6 sh	All classical and modern foreign languages are accepted. Must demonstrate proficiency or have credit through the second introductory level to fulfill the foreign language requirement.
Health and Wellness	Min 2 sh	Both lecture and activity components are required to fulfill the HW requirement. A lecture course that does not contain a comprehensive fitness development component will not fulfill the HW requirement. If UNCA accepts a course in transfer that satisfies the lecture component of the HW requirement, student still need to complete an activity course.
Laboratory Science	Min 4 sh	Any physical or natural science that has a lab such as biology, chemistry, physics, geology, astronomy, etc. Can also use a two-course sequence with a lab, as long as it is at least 4 semester hours. <b>Students cannot use the same course to fulfill both the Laboratory Science and ILSN Topical Cluster requirement.</b>
Mathematics	Min 4 sh	Any 4-hour MATH- or STAT-prefixed course at or above the College Algebra level.

### ILS Topical Cluster

Students must complete at least 3 courses (a minimum of 9 semester hours) from one Topical Cluster. Their choices must include one 3-hour ILS Natural Science course; one 3-hour ILS Social Science course; and 3 hours in ILS Arts-designated courses or a 3-hour elective.

ILS-Natural Science (ILSN)	Min 3 sh	Students may use a transferred course to fulfill the ILSN requirement if it is equivalent to an ILSN course listed as part of a Cluster. Students must complete their ILSS and ILSA/Elective courses within the same cluster. <b>Students cannot use the same course to fulfill both the ILSN and the Laboratory Science requirements.</b>
ILS-Social Science (ILSS)	Min 3 sh	Students may use a transferred course to fulfill the ILSS requirement if it is equivalent to an ILSS course listed as part of a Cluster. Students must complete their ILSN and ILSA/Elective courses within the same cluster.
ILS Arts <i>or</i> Elective	Min 3 sh	Students may use a transferred course to fulfill the Elective requirement if it is equivalent to a course listed as part of the Topical Cluster. See ILS Arts above for more information.

### ILS Intensive Requirements

Many transferred courses do not automatically fulfill intensive requirements with the following exceptions. Students have the option of petitioning for a transferred course to count as an intensive requirement. Interested students should complete an [Intensive Petition Form](#) and return it to the Office of the Registrar. **A course syllabus must accompany each petition.**

Diversity (DI)		
Information Literacy (ILI)		Students receive credit for one ILI if a transferred course is equated to LANG 120.
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Quantitative (QI)		Students receive credit for the QI requirement if transfer credit is received for two Math courses, or one Math and one Computer Science or other appropriate course totaling at least 6 semester hours,
Writing (WI)		Students receive credit for one WI if transfer credit is received for a two-course composition sequence.
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
